The Helen K. Jones Woman of Strength Award was created in 2009 to honor the life of Helen Jones, former president of Recovery Resources. Helen lived her life as a woman of strength. She believed that the beauty of a woman is not in the clothes she wears, the figure she carries or the way she combs her hair, but in the beliefs she carries, the issues she advocates for and the injustices she fights against.

Myrtle I. Muntz will be recognized as the 2011 Helen K. Jones Woman of Strength Award recipient. A former president and chief executive officer of Recovery Resources, Ms. Muntz is currently the Vice President, Advancement at Notre Dame College in South Euclid, Ohio and principal of Muntz Consulting Services, where she assists nonprofit organizations in addressing fundamental issues of governance and development. While at Recovery Resources, Ms Muntz led a capital campaign for acquisition and renovation of a headquarters building, engineered and implemented two highly successful mergers, and helped create an organizational endowment fund. During her 35 years of non-profit management, she received national recognition both for her leadership and for her development of innovative service delivery models. Ms. Muntz is the  
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recipient of the 2000 Leadership in Nonprofit Management Award from the Mandel Center for Nonprofit Management at Case Western Reserve University and the 2007 MSASS-Mandel Center distinguished Alumni Award. Her commitment to the success of non-profit organizations and to the Recovery Resources family make her an ideal recipient of this prestigious award.
